## GUIDE TO S.O.A.P's

### **S: for Scripture**

Take time reading and allow God to speak to you. When you are done, look for a verse that particularly spoke to you that day, and write it in your journal.

### **O: for Observation**

What do you think God is saying to you in this scripture? Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you and reveal Jesus to you. Paraphrase and write this scripture down in your own words. What is this verse saying?

### **A: for Application**

Personalize what you have read by asking yourself how it applies to your life right now. Perhaps it is instruction, encouragement, revelation of a new promise, or corrections for a particular area of your life. Write how this scripture can apply to you today.

### **P: for Prayer**

This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this scripture, or it may be a greater insight on what he may be revealing to you. Remember, prayer is a two way street, so be sure to listen to what God has to say! Now write it out!

**1. Underline or highlight key words or phrases in the Bible passage.**

*Use a pen or highlighter to mark new discoveries from the text. Periodically review your markings to see what God is teaching you.*

**2. Put it into your own words.**

*Read the passage or verse slowly, then rewrite each phrase or sentence using your own words.*

**3. Ask and answer some questions.**

*Questions unlock new discoveries and meanings. Ask questions about the passage using these words: who, what, why, when, where, or how. Jot down some thoughts on how you would answer these questions.*

**4. Capture the big ideas.**

*God's Word communicates big ideas. Periodically ask, What's the big idea in this sentence, paragraph, or chapter?*

**5. Personalize the meaning.**

*When God speaks to us through the Scriptures, we must respond. A helpful habit is personalizing the Bible through application. Ask: How could my life be different today as I respond to what I'm reading?*
