

What is Beach Camp?

CSM Beach Camp is a 3-4 day experience for students to connect with each other and connect with God on a deeper level.

What is Beach Camp like?

Beach camp is meant to be both a fun experience, and a focused opportunity for your student to explore faith. Your student will get to play fun games, spend a lot of time at the beach, participate in small groups, explore the Bible with daily devotionals, and be a part of a nightly worship experience. We encourage students to disconnect from technology and social media, and be fully present during their time at beach camp.

Is there a registration deadline?

Yes! Registration closes at 11:59PM on August 10th.

Where is the camp located?

This year's beach camp will be located at San Onofre State Beach at the Bluffs Group Campsite.

How much is Beach Camp?

Beach Camp is \$125 dollars--scholarships are available.

Are meals provided?

Yes! Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, Water, and snacks are provided. If your child has any dietary restrictions, please let us know ahead of time so we can work out the necessary accommodations.

Do we need to provide our own tent?

Yes.

Do students and leaders share tents?

Yes. There will always be leaders with multiple students in a tent. There will never be one leader alone with one student in a tent. All tents are assigned by grade and gender.

What are the camp activities?

What if my child is about to enter 6th grade?

If your child is in 5th grade and will be in 6th grade this upcoming school year, than beach camp is for them! Beach Camp is for students from 6-12th grade.

Who will be there?

-All paid student ministry staff (Student Pastor, Student Ministry Director), Intern(s), as well as our leaders who serve during our weekend/Wednesday night service. All staff and volunteers have been background checked

How will my student get to camp?

Transportation will be provided to and from the campsite by bus. This is included in the cost of beach camp.

What are the starting and ending times?

We leave The Crossing Church Sunday, August 11th at 1:00PM. We return to The Crossing Church, Wednesday, August 14th at 12:00PM. We do end the night off with Beach Camp Live. That is open to all families and students who attend CSM and is during our regular service time (Wednesday nights 6:30-8:30).

What should my child wear and bring to camp?

We suggest comfortable clothes that your student(s) won't mind getting a little dirty. We spend a significant amount of time outside. We also provide a list of what to bring for beach camp. You can find it here (hyperlink to google doc).
